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Volunteering Areas Descriptions

Board Member - The Board meets the Third Tuesday of each month at 7pm for roughly an hour. You do not need to be a member at Cary United Methodist Church to be on the Board.

Play Dough Volunteer - (See Play Dough Sign-up Sheet) The preschool will provide all items needed to make play dough. You take them home the items and make the play dough on your own time and bring it back on your child's next school day.

Classroom Helper - The parent will come in to help with duties as assigned by the teachers (example: fill paint, cutting, organizing, filing...)

Library Helper - The parents will help enter and label new books into the library system.

Ice Cream Social Helper - Parents will help set up and decorate for the ice cream social.

Teacher Appreciation Helper - Parents will help plan and make small gifts for teacher with the help of the director.

Christmas Program Helper - Parents will help set up and decorate for the Christmas Program
